**SUBJECT: CONSTANT COMPLAINTS FROM EXPORTERS
REGARDING DAMAGES TO EXPORT CARGO AT THE
TERMINALS.**

Dear Sirs,

1. Constant complaints are received from Exporters through Ministry of Port & Shipping that during examination of goods, the cartons / packages of export goods are taken out from the box or LCL cargo cartons are opened as well as rolls of fabric garments are spread out on the ground for examination during which the same get damaged with stains of oil etc. and also shortage of quantity has been observed.
2. As the export goods are handled in your custody and being custodian of cargo the Terminals / Yards Operators are to ensure safe / secure handling upto the satisfaction of Port / Terminal users.
3. It is, therefore, advised to Terminal / Yard Operators that all precautionary, safety / security and other measures are to be ensured during examination of goods, to prevent the damages, shortages as such happenings, affects on the commitments of exporters in fulfillment of national / international obligations.
