I am directed to refer to Directorate General of Transit Trade, Karachi's letter No.S1/MISC/Office-30/2013-TG dated 10.06.2013 on the subject cited above and to say that the Board, vide its earlier letters of even number dated 22.01.2013 and dated 06.06.2013, while allowing cross-stuffing and release of held-up consignments of Afghan Transit Export Cargo containing perishable goods, has already settled the principle that such consignments shall be allowed cross-stuffing and release, as export thereof under ATT is not banned, Hence, there is no point in holding up such future consignments and making a reference to Board again.
